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Logging in

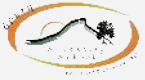

Open a web browser and search for google. Click on the Sign In button and sign in using your school email address.





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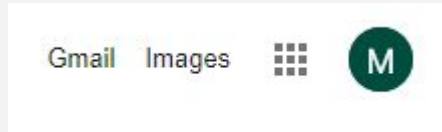

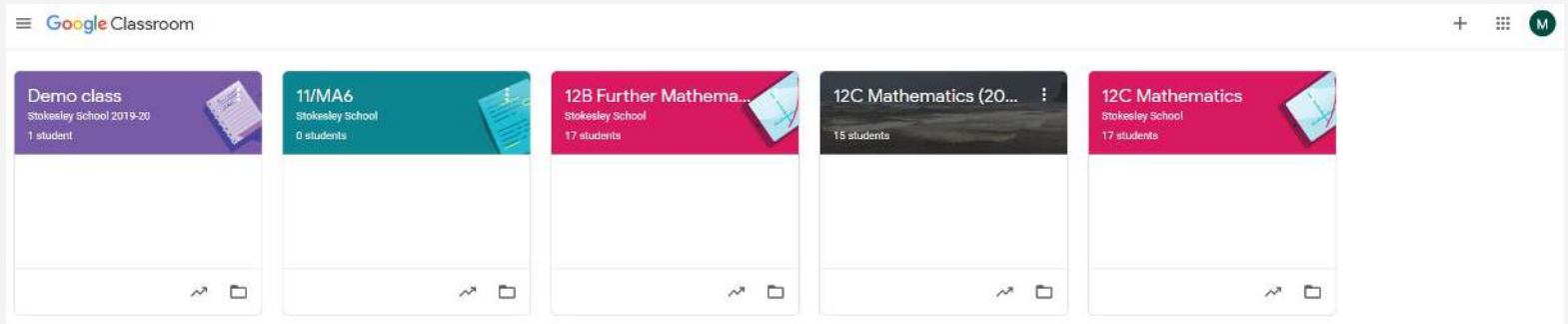

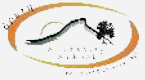
Click on Classwork at the top. This will take you to the work you have been set to do. Click on each section and follow the instructions, complete the work to the very best of your ability.

Your teachers will be looking at these assignments and giving you feedback. Either in the assignment itself or by sharing a whole class feedback sheet. If your teacher does give you feedback, make sure you make the improvements in your document in green font!



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Accessing your work again

If you are set an assignment the work will be copied into a folder in your drive called Classroom. You can access your drive by clicking on 9 dots again and choosing drive.



If you need to access any of your work you can do it through classroom, or via this folder.



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Other work

Your teacher may also set you work from outside google, for example on Hegartymaths.

The details of this will still be posted in the google classroom though so make sure you login and check what you have to do every day.



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If you are stuck

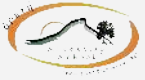
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Email your teacher! But bear in mind you may not get a response straight away.
