## **Stokesley Sixth Form Curriculum Offer**

Dear Y11,

I am delighted to inform you of our curriculum offer for Y12 2020/2021.

### *What subjects are on offer?*

We have considered your initial subject choices in detail to ensure that we have offered as varied a curriculum as possible. We are excited to announce that we have used our position within the Areté Learning Trust, along with video conferencing technology, to expand our curriculum wider than in recent years. This includes the offer of learning A-Level Law, something that was not available until now.

### *What subjects should I choose?*

The subjects are split into five blocks, found on the next page. You must choose three subjects (four in certain circumstances, such as selecting further maths) that feature in separate blocks. Each subject is hyperlinked to its specification so you can see what the course involves in more detail.

### *When do I officially apply to the sixth form?*

Applications officially take place on GCSE results day, 20th August. Usually students would pick up their grades from the main hall, where staff will be present and ready to sign students up to the sixth form. This letter provides you with the subjects available to you so that you can plan your choices carefully in advance

### *What do I need to enter the sixth form?*

The entry requirements to the sixth form are a minimum of five grade 4s, ideally including English and mathematics. Students who do not attain a grade 4 in GCSE English or mathematics would be required to 'resit' the exam should they join the sixth form. Some subjects, such as the sciences, have extra grade recommendations, all of which can be read in the [Stokesley Sixth Form Prospectus](#).
