Learn a new skill. You could get some ideas from <a href="#">this one of our weekly bulletins</a> .	Complete a purple colour walk. Take photographs of anything that is purple when you are out on a walk and put them together in a collage (see example on next page).	Write a letter or an email to a teacher from your Primary School who has had a positive impact on your life so far.
Bake something and take a picture of it. Challenge - could you incorporate any purple?	Take a selfie! You may want to do this one when you have your full uniform on.	Come up with three questions that you would like to ask your form tutor.
Make a video/voice recording about you and your life to share with your tutor during the first couple of weeks back.	Create a checklist of the equipment and uniform you will need for Stokesley School and display it in an interesting way.	Choose an issue you feel strongly about and come up with a way of raising awareness. You don't have to do it, it could just be an idea, but you might want to!
<b>YOUR OWN CHOICE!</b> Do something of your choice that could relate to being ambitious, ready or respectful (or even all three!).	Make a poster which shows how you already demonstrate being ambitious, ready and respectful.	Do some research on where your name originates from and display it in a creative way.

**Remember you can choose which line you want to do as long as it goes across or down. If you're feeling really ambitious, go for the full house! And keep all evidence in a folder ready to bring with you in September! Good luck!**
