


## Multisensory audit

This shows a range of approaches for different ages. It would need to be coordinated for the particular class or child.

Skill	Say 	Kinaesthetic 	Visual 	Auditory 
Teach alphabet and ordering skills	Recite alphabet rhyme as a class when lining up	Rainbow alphabet work in small group		
Teach letter sound links		Wooden letters in a feely bag in group session. Also on table during spelling work		
Teach decoding skills		Give class differentiated cards of phonemes or syllables. Move and make words		Model decoding during whole-class text work. Discuss why it is important and how to break a word up
Improve visualisation and visual memory	Whole class – show picture from story for 30 seconds. Cover. Tell partner what you remember. Discuss what helped and what didn't		Challenge children to extend the number of letters they can copy at one time. Say letter names to help	
Improve auditory memory	Repeat instructions			
Help pupils learn spellings			Colour code parts of the word that are similar	
Teach sequencing and sequences				Use picture prompts and paired work to retell story
