

Year 10 EVENT OPERATIONS

Our Level 1/2 Award in Event Operations has been designed to offer exciting and interesting experiences that focus on skills through learning by doing. The qualification is devised around a 'plan, do, review' approach to learning, where learners are introduced to a concept, carry out activities and review outcomes and learning.

During Year 10 the students are able to put into practise their practical skills of Teamwork, problem solving and communication which they have learnt and developed throughout Year 9.

Students build knowledge through a combination of teacher-and-student-led learning which is then applied to a range of different scenarios and events, including practice summative questions, mini-essay type answers, event and personal performance analysis, presentational work and a wide variety of mediums (e.g. poster work, practical observations and group discussion).
