

## Year 11 FINE ART

The emphasis in year 11 is to work independently and produce a personal response to the portrait project. After Christmas, students will receive an exam paper with a number of starting points to choose from. They will be assisted in selecting the best project for them and coached throughout the project with very clear reminders of deadlines.
