Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 11 Result Day and Year 9 and 10 Results Collection

We are looking forward to results day. For most students, results day is a happy and simple occasion where they celebrate the success of their hard work and move onto the next planned stages of their educational journey. In the rare instance where this is not the case, we have experienced personnel in place on the day to support you and your child.

Arrangements for the day

GCSE Results Day will take place on Thursday 25th August between 10am - 12noon for Year 11, with students in Year 9 and Year 10 being allowed to collect their results between 12noon - 1pm.

Due to extensive refurbishment in several areas of the school over the summer break, students will be collecting results from the gym and not the main hall. Students will enter through the green gate adjacent to the DT block and make their way around the back of the building towards the gym. Members of staff will be there to meet them at each point. To reduce the amount of people accessing the site, please may we request that parents/carers do not accompany their child into the building. If your child requires support, a member of the team will come and get you.

Students will be invited to attend school at staggered intervals, each within a ten minute timeframe. They will attend at their allotted time and follow a one way system around the back of the building into the gym. Students will travel around the hall in a clockwise manner. They will visit three points:

- results stations to collect results envelopes;
- intended future destinations desk;
- Stokesley School Sixth Form sign up desks and/or careers support for those intending to go to other colleges..

Please note that we will have support pods set up in the classrooms in the sixth form block for students who may require individual private support. If your child requires such support, the parent/carers who has accompanied them will be invited to participate in that conversation.





Students need to follow the schedule below and must not arrive at school until their allotted slot. This is to allow a staggered collection time for support and sixth form registration:

Within the letter we shared three weeks ago, we gave students the option to have their results emailed to them. If your child is not intending on coming into school to collect their results and have not already done so, please ensure your child has completed the [Google form](#) by Thursday 20th July at 4pm This will then allow our team to ensure everything is in place in time for results day. If we have not had a response from your child, they will have to collect their results in person on results day.

Queries

Should you have any questions in relation to the information in this letter, please contact our exams@stokesleyschool.org email address which will be manned until Friday 22nd July. The exams office will then reopen from Monday 15th August until Thursday 25th August. Support will continue to be provided following the results day - should it be required, but any queries after 25th August will receive a response from Monday 5th September. Please note that any potential appeals cannot be submitted until Mrs Darby, Exam's Officer and I have been able to consult with teaching staff, who will return from annual leave on Monday 5th September.

Appeals

In the event that your child would wish to make an appeal against a grade, they should submit their request via this [google](#) form using your child's school email address. Your child will receive an automatic response to this. KS4 appeals are not classed as priority appeals by the examination boards. Therefore, the examinations team will be prioritising any A Level appeals during the summer break.





All KS4 appeals will be treated as none priority in accordance with the JCQ guidance. All non priority apples have to be submitted by Friday 9th September, 1pm.
