Year 11 Leeds Thackray Museum - 10.01.23

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to inform you that we have arranged to take year 11 students to the Thackray Medical Museum in Leeds to investigate the development of medicine and surgery in Britain over time.

The visit will take place on Tuesday 10th January 2023. As students study 'Britain: Health and the People' as part of their GCSE History course, this will be a valuable day to enrich the curriculum and help support the progress of your child.

Students will have a variety of experiences during the day including studying the various exhibits regarding medical developments in Britain and they will also have an interactive talk on the history of surgery looking at key problems that surgeons of the past faced. The interactive workshop will take place in an authentic Victorian Operating Theatre so students can soak up some of the atmosphere. Accompanying the talk is a range of museum objects, shown to students in the operating theatre and in the museum galleries. Students will be encouraged to interact with the session leader to understand the experiences and attitudes of the past.

Students will move between the different locations on foot after arriving by coach. As we are working in a public area, we will discuss health and safety and our risk assessment with the students in lessons. We would appreciate it if you could reiterate the key message of listening to instructions and being aware of the responsibilities of working in public and busy locations with your child.

Students will be required to go to their tutors at 8.45am as normal to be registered and then the bus will leave as soon as possible after this. We will be returning at approximately 4pm at school. As this will be after the departure of normal school buses, please ensure that there has been alternative transport arranged for your child. Students can be supervised until 4.30pm to allow working parents/carers to come and pick them up; please let us know if you will need to make use of this facility.

Students will be required to wear full school uniforms. They should bring a pen and pencil and if they have one, a clipboard. Students should bring a packed lunch; anyone who normally receives a free school meal may have one provided. Please indicate at the bottom if you require us to provide lunch for your child on that day. Students may wish to bring some money as there is a gift shop at the museum.

In order to cover the costs of the trip including museum fees and transport, the cost of the trip will be **£26.00** per pupil, which is due by Friday 6th January 2023. If you have financial difficulty making the full contribution please contact the Finance Department who may be able to assist with staggering payments. Payment can be made using the online system ParentPay. Please log into your account and select 'Items to Pay' and then select **Year 11 Thackray 2023**. You will be able to make payment via debit or credit card.





If you have not already done so, can you make sure the whole school consent form has been returned to school or inform us of any changes to your child's medical circumstances, as we will use this information to write our risk assessment. Please also return the slip below. Please advise the school of any changes to your child's medical information held in school.

As always, we appreciate the support given to the History department by parents and if you require any further information about the trip, please contact me at school.
