The school will be using the same system we introduced two years ago, allowing you to easily book your online appointments. You can choose your own appointment times with teachers and you will receive an email confirming your appointments.

Each appointment will last nine minutes. The video call will automatically end at this point, this allows appointments not to run over for the next parent/carer who will be waiting.
