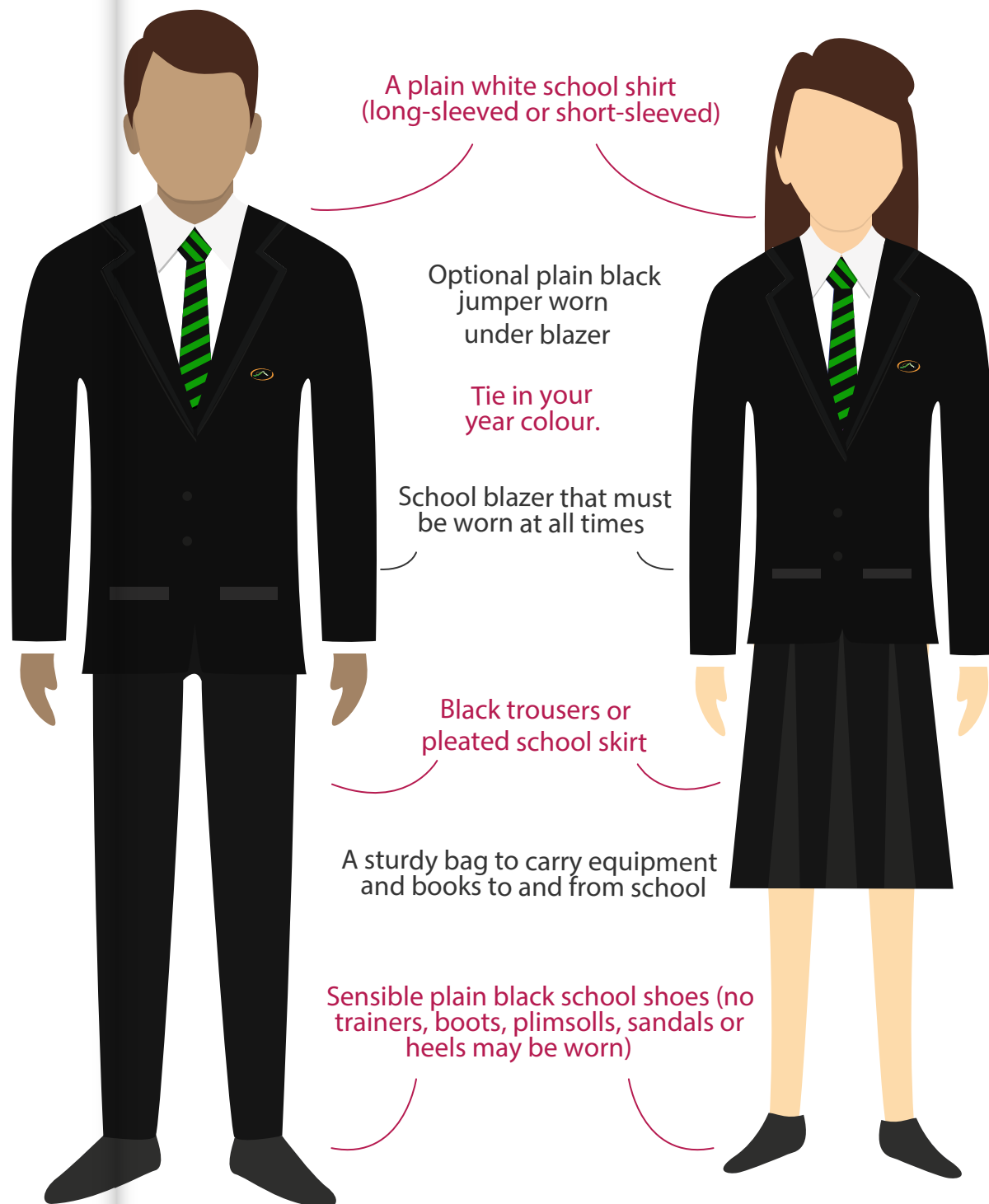
We will be holding a uniform sizing event in school on

Each of our year groups have a specific tie colour.



The following are not allowed in school:

- any blazers not bought directly from Stokesley School's uniform supplier
- non-black belts or overly elaborate, decorative belts
- make-up including nail varnish and false nails
- Tight fitting or legging type trousers are not allowed in school
- Hoodies and sports tops worn as coats and under blazers
- no jewellery except a watch may be worn. Earrings are not allowed
- tattoos including henna tattoos
- non-natural coloured hair
- headwear including caps (unless specified by school)
- sunglasses
- **mobile phones are banned in school, they must be switched off and in bags at all times**



Girls' PE Kit



Compulsory items:



- School logo polo shirt
- Shorts - plain black
- Plain white ankle socks (indoor)
- Plain black football socks (outdoor)
- Football boots (moulded studs can be worn on the grass and AstroTurf)
- Training shoes with non-marking soles
- Shin pads (required for football and hockey)
- Towel
- One-piece swimming costume
- Hair fastening, if required



Optional items:

- Hoody - plain black
- Plain black leggings



Boys' PE Kit



Compulsory items:



- School logo t-shirt
- Shorts - plain black
- Plain black football socks (outdoor)
- Plain white ankle socks (indoor)
- Football boots (moulded studs can be worn on the grass and AstroTurf)
- Training shoes with non-marking soles
- Shin pads (required for football and hockey)
- Towel
- Swimming trunks / shorts
- Hair fastening, if required

Your Equipment

To make sure you are ready to learn, you'll need to bring the right equipment with you.

This includes:

- a pencil case
- two working black pens and a green pen
- two pencils, a pencil sharpener and an eraser
- casio calculator - models: fx-83gtx, fx-85gtplus or fx-85gtx classwiz and a ruler
- a chromebook provided through our leasing scheme, charged to at least 75%
- a pair of headphones / earphones for your chromebook
- a reasonably sized bag to hold your books, equipment and school planner



Chromebooks



In order to give you access to the digital world we have introduced a one-to-one device ratio in school.

We have a leasing scheme so that you can lease a device (Chromebook) to use in school and at home that will become yours to own once all payments are made. This will cost approximately £12 a month over three years; this is a significant saving over what you would be able to find privately.

We know that some of you may already own a device that you may wish to use in school. This is of course something that we are happy for you to do: if you choose to bring your own device in you need to make sure that you look after it as it is your property and we cannot be responsible for keeping it safe.

We advise you to insure your device.

Paying for your food

At Stokesley School we have a cashless system called ParentPay. This system allows you to pay for school lunches or snacks, trips and activities. Your parent/carer will have an online account that they can pay money into and, by using your finger print, you can use the money in the account to pay for your food in school.
