Post 18 Options Parental Support Evening

On Tuesday 12th September we are inviting our Year 13 parents to come and join us to find out about the year ahead and specifically to explain more about the process behind both applying to university through UCAS and/or finding employment, apprenticeships or degree apprenticeships.

Year 13 is obviously an incredibly important year for your child and for you, with big decisions needing to be made over the next few months. This event helps you to understand how best to support your child through this time and what support they will receive from us at Stokesley Sixth Form.

This year's event will run from 6:15-7:00pm. We politely request that you arrive for registration between 6:00-6:15pm to take your seats in the main hall for a prompt start. At registration you will receive a handout which you will refer to throughout the evening; you will also be able to take this away with you for reference.

Following the presentation, in the LIFE hub, there will be the opportunity to speak to key members of the sixth form team to answer any individual queries you may have. This will include members of the senior leadership team and Mrs Jeal, Director of Sixth Form.

Please note that due to high numbers we can only allow two parents/carers per child. The students are being given this information through LIFE lessons and through assembly, so they do not have to attend with you, but are welcome should you wish them to.
