We hope that your child has enjoyed their first term of Year 11 Geography where we have focused on natural hazards and the physical geography fieldwork at Redcar. Recent progress reports and the parent evening were intended to be informative, celebrate success and identify areas for development. Many parents asked if we could summarise the support available, so they can help their child with their studies in this subject.

## February Formal Assessments

As part of the whole school assessment programme we will be having a mock exam in February. The exam will cover the following topic areas:

- Living World Ecosystems, Tropical Rainforests & Deserts
- Natural Hazards Tectonic hazards, Weather hazards & Climate Change
- Fieldwork A 9 mark question on the human fieldwork (Newcastle Quayside)
- Geographical Skills Testing a range of skills covered across the course so far

The exam is a mixture of past GCSE questions and will help us identify what intervention is required to allow students to make the best progress, as we fast approach the summer exam period.

#### Google Classroom

In Year 10, all students were invited to join a Google Classroom specifically set up for all GCSE Geography revision. This has topic checklists, all you need to know presentations, knowledge organisers to complete, case study booklets, past questions and model answers as well as skills workbooks.
