Dear Parent / Carer

Just before Christmas I discussed the opportunity for students in Year 10 to join the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Silver Programme and your child has expressed an interest in signing up to the programme. We would like to sign the students up over the next few weeks so that they can begin their award formally this month.

The silver award is a significant commitment and involves a programme of between 6 and 12 months taking part in volunteering, physical activity, skill development, and two expeditions. The cost of completing the award is £190 and this can be paid off in instalments over the year.

Instalments would be as follows:

- £90, end February
- £50 end of March
- £50 end April

Payments cover the following:

- Initial registration
- Welcome pack
- Assessors fees
- Leaders fees/training
- Bus hire
- Replenishment of stock including (tents/rucksacks/trangias/roll mats/gas/maps/compasses/first aid/emergency shelters)
- Campsite fees

Payment can be made by logging on to your ParentPay account and selecting 'D of E Silver Award 2024'.

If the cost of the programme seems like it may be a barrier to taking part, please do get in touch with us to see how we may be able to help out.

I will be meeting regularly with students to help them log and sign off their different sections, offering advice and guidance on how they can complete these in a timely fashion.

- Volunteering section: 6 months
- Physical and Skills sections: One section for 6 months and the other section for 3 months
- Expedition section: 3 days/2 nights

If a student did not do their Bronze Award, they must undertake a further 6 months in either the Volunteering or the longer of the Physical or Skills sections so that one section totals 12 months.

It is important that students, parents, and carers understand this commitment from the outset. Each year we have several students who begin the award and do not finish it as they cannot commit the time to the sections that need to be completed outside of school.

There was a strong expression of interest from students so I wanted to set the programme out to you in a letter so you can decide if you would like to support your child's involvement.

We will host a brief parent and carer information and recruitment session ahead of the first training meeting at 5:30pm on Wednesday 17th January. We would request that each student attends with a parent or carer. Students would then stay for the first introductory session from 6pm until 7:30pm with our team of Silver Award leaders and those who are interested but undecided can then have a discussion with parents following the induction and make a decision about whether they wish to commit to the programme.
