

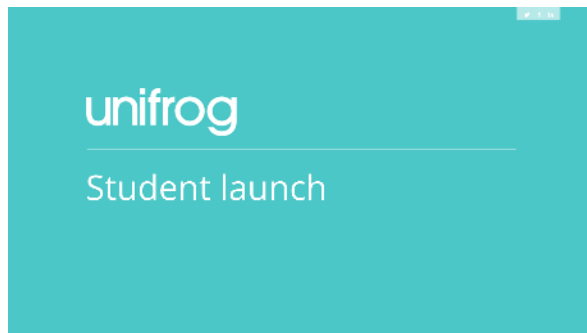
National Careers Week

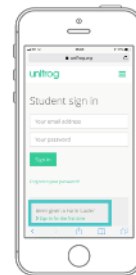
Stokesley students will be looking at National Careers week in their LIFE lesson and International women's day in their assemblies next week.


