**Update on A Level Crime Day - Teesside University - Wednesday 4th December 9.30-3.30pm**

I am pleased to announce that this school trip will now be fully subsidised by the university, so we are therefore offering refunds to those students who have paid the £7.50 travel fee and have also extended the invite to other Y12 Psychology students who are wishing to attend.

We will be providing transport via coach from Stokesley School to Teesside University on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December at 9am for a 9.30am start and then returning to Stokesley at around 4pm after a 3.30pm finish time. Students will be required to bring their own lunches and to arrange their own way home from Stokesley School at around 4pm.

The event is an interactive day where students watch a pre-recorded crime taking place, and then spend time in the labs and replica courtroom to understand the different approaches taken by crime scene and forensic scientists, crime scene investigators, cybersecurity specialists, criminologists and legal professionals, in solving modern crimes.

This is a valuable enrichment opportunity that is particularly relevant to any Sociology and Psychology students as it will tie in directly to students' studies, covering a range of content from the courses which should be beneficial.
